

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA, AMENDING THE MONROVIA MUNICIPAL CODE BY MOVING THE DATE OF THE CITY'S GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FROM THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN MARCH OF ODD-NUMBERED YEARS TO THE SECOND TUESDAY OF APRIL OF ODD-NUMBERED YEARS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA DOES hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.20.010 of Chapter 2.20 of Title 2 of the Monrovia Municipal Code regarding City elections is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 2.20.010 DATE OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

Pursuant to Cal. Elections Code § 1301(b) and commencing on January 1, 2009, the date of the General Municipal Election is moved from the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March of each odd-numbered year to the second Tuesday in April of each odd-numbered year.”

Section 2. Section 2.20.20 of Chapter 2.20 of Title 2 of the Monrovia Municipal Code regarding notice to registered voters is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Section 2.20.030 of Chapter 2.20 of Title 2 of the Monrovia Municipal Code regarding incumbents' terms of office is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 2.20.020 EXTENSION OF INCUMBENTS' TERMS.

Section 4. Those terms of office that would have expired in March 2009 are hereby extended to the second Tuesday in April 2009, and those terms of office that would have expired in March 2011 are hereby extended to the second Tuesday in April 2011.”

Section 5. The remaining Sections shall be renumbered accordingly.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its final passage. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance.
