

land use, transportation network improvements, transportation demand managements, transportation systems management, non-motorized transportation, transit level of service, and pricing.

Given that SCAG has been directed to develop a target that is both “ambitious” and “achievable”, SCAG is recommending a target range of 7-9% per capita reductions for 2020 and 5-10% per capita reductions for 2035. This month, ARB will review the targets submitted by all MPOs and release draft targets. ARB will release draft targets for all MPOs in September 2010.
