## **2.0 Discussion Items**

### **2.1 Update on County-Wide AB 811 Implementation Efforts**

#### **2.1.1 Status of Key Decision Points**

The County and consultant team are currently developing a Program Design Manual. The next step will be to develop tools and resources such as collateral materials. The County anticipates adopting its resolution on April 6<sup>th</sup>. Cities will be able to pass resolutions beginning 60 days after this date. Financing is anticipated to be available in July or August 2010.

#### **2.1.2 Status of Grant Applications**

The County was not funded for its two State Energy Program grant applications. The County is now reassessing and strategizing for alternative financing options.

### **2.2 Update on San Gabriel Valley Efforts**

#### **2.2.1 City "In-kind" Contributions**

There was discussion regarding city plans for providing funds or in-kind staff time in support of the program. COG staff is surveying the cities to collect this information.

#### **2.2.2 Marketing and Educational Materials**

COG staff discussed the home energy performance materials developed for city use. Members should contact staff with any changes or suggestions for additional materials to be developed.

### **2.3 San Gabriel Valley Energy Wise Partnership**

#### **2.3.1 Resolution of Participation**

SCE has notified COG staff that cities will be required to adopt a resolution of participation to receive the enhanced rebate for their energy efficiency projects. COG staff is waiting to receive a sample resolution from SCE and will distribute it once it is made available.

#### **2.3.2 EE Project List**

Staff reviewed the project list. A stimulus workshop is being planned to discuss project status and reporting for the end of March.

#### **2.3.3 On-Bill Financing Program**

Staff reviewed the components of this program. Applications are anticipated to be available in April on a first-come, first-serve basis.

#### **2.3.4 Community HEP Workshops**

The San Gabriel Valley Energy Wise Partnership will offer four home energy performance workshops in the Valley. The targeted timeframe for these workshops is spring/early summer. Cities interested in hosting a workshop should contact COG staff.

### **2.3.5 Direct Install Program**

Staff reviewed the components of a program. The SCE Direct Install scheduled will be emailed to participants.

### **2.3.6 California Long-Term Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan RFP**

Staff provided an overview of this funding opportunity and the RFP requirements. Staff reviewed the four proposed work plan activities and solicited input for additional activities that were eligible based on the menu list. No other suggestions were provided. Cities wishing to be included in the proposal should submit a letter of participation to the COG by March 1st. If a city is submitting its own proposal it cannot be included in the COG proposal. COG staff requested volunteers to be on a proposal review committee that would review and comment on iterations of the COG proposal.

Staff will send out a summary of action items requested at today's meeting. Staff will continue to coordinate with the County regarding the AB 811 program and provide updates as available.
